No Limit International is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization with the mission statement: engage communities around the world in lifelong best practices aimed at improving health and living conditions, fighting hunger and poverty, providing youth educational and recreational activities, and empowering people to believe in a better society. In short, we strive to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) identified by the United Nations and called the 2030 Agenda.

Thus, we have identified 7 Goals and outcome targets that are part of our mission to make a better world for all of us by 2030. Since the onset of the nonprofit organization, we have enacted several awareness campaigns and taken action in various ways to make a difference around the world.



# GOAL 1: NO POVERTY

Extreme poverty remains prevalent in low-income countries in Sub-Saharan Africa particularly those affected by conflict and political upheaval. In 2021, More than half of all Africans live below the poverty line (on less than \$1.50 a day).

Securing access to land is critical for millions of poor people, especially in Africa. We've been providing land access to vulnerable population such as displaced persons victims of war conflict in Cameroon, West Africa. Land farming and agricultural productivity are essential elements to income generation and access to basic life necessities for the whole family.

Our goal is to help communities become self-sufficient by mobilizing resources and providing more land opportunities to the poor and as such, contribute to the end of poverty.





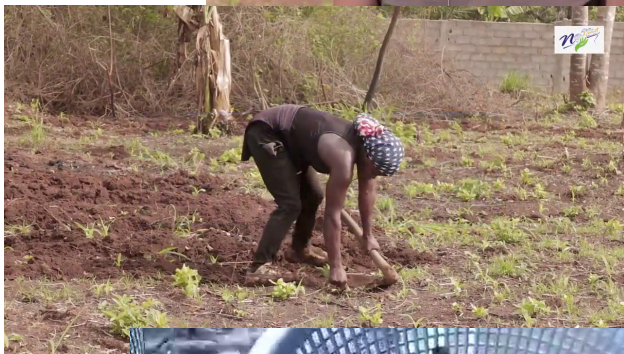

Through our “land for food security” program, we give the opportunity to underprivileged population struggling to have one meal per day to secure arable land for farming at no cost and nourish their families adequately. The advent of Covid-19 affected the lives of billions of people around the world in many ways. In fact, the pandemic claimed thousands of lives and changed the world economy at an unprecedented level. During these challenging times, we have provided assistance to the vulnerable population in America and Africa by distributing facemasks, hand sanitizers, building hand washing stations in rural communities, organizing awareness campaigns about the virus outbreak and its devastating impact in the world. We also promoted safe schools during the pandemic by organizing campaign awareness in the school community and distributing educational flyers with pertinent information regarding the deadly virus. Also, the pandemic resulted in lockdowns that led to a rise in teenage pregnancies in Africa, further exacerbating poverty and inequality. The long-term consequences of early and unwanted pregnancies on young girls call for immediate action. Our goal is to build primary health care clinics in communities that are manpowered by healthcare professionals who can provide adequate access to sexual and reproductive care, family planning and education. We also want to conduct Covid-19 vaccination campaign awareness

and the importance of getting vaccinated against the virus.

We have promoted sports activities in the youth community by partnering with the Cameroon Swimming Federation as a channel to boost self-confidence, sportsmanship, and healthy habits. We have organized swim meets to promote swimming as a sport in the country. Drowning rates are very high in Cameroon and we frequently organize workshops to educate the community about water safety and drowning prevention programs.

Our goal is to build a community swimming pool recreation center accessible to all in Cameroon; a country where the sport of swimming is still a luxury and not affordable to the less fortunate. We want the youth to engage in swimming activities as a fun and competitive sport and encourage adults and senior citizens to take advantage of this sports complex to practice a sport that is great for general well-being.

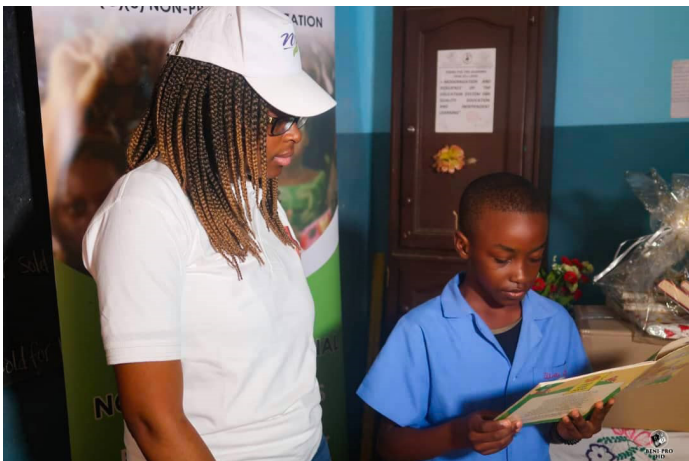


## GOAL 4: QUALITY EDUCATION

We organize workshops for women economic empowerment, which help them build life skills that are essential to their sustainable development. According to UN Women, women's economic empowerment is central to realizing women's rights and gender equality. In fact, empowering women in the economy and closing gender gaps in the world of work are key
